

# Learn to play:

## Guitar, fiddle, banjo, mandolin, bass or ukulele

### What

Small, one-hour, 10-week group lessons offered on guitar, fiddle, banjo, mandolin, bass or ukulele at beginning, intermediate, and advanced levels of instruction. Following the group lessons, there will be a free jam session, lead by Dr. Chris Scales, his MSU music students, and volunteers from the community. MSU, LCC, high school students and all community members are welcome.



### When

Tuesday evenings, Sept. 8–Nov. 10, and Feb. 2–April 13, 2010

- Beginning group lessons: 6:30–7:30 p.m.
- Intermediate group lessons: 7:30–8:30 p.m.
- Advanced group lessons: 8:30–9:30 p.m.

The free jam session starts at 7:30 p.m. and continues throughout the evening. Students are encouraged to join before and/or after their group lessons.

### Where

Lessons are offered at the Residential College in Arts and Humanities (RCAH) located in Snyder/Philips Halls on the Michigan State University campus. Music jams will take place in the RCAH lobby. After 6 p.m., parking on campus is free.

### Cost

**\$124 for a 10-week group lesson including the free, weekly jam session.**

**\$99 for RCAH (Residential College in Arts and Humanities) students.**

The Tuesday night jams are free and open to the public.

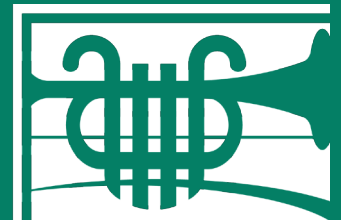
