The MSU Choral Union is designed as a cooperative cultural collaboration between the university and the local community. Singers include faculty, staff, students, and community musicians. Repertoire is focused on major choral/orchestral works representing historical and contemporary music.

Because all the material taught in the class is presented during rehearsals, your consistent attendance is required. You are allowed two absences per term.

The only excused absences will be for required university functions (class field trips, exams, tours), religious holidays, and written medical documentation (please do not disclose medical information, just documentation of your visit). You are not excused for study sessions, job responsibilities, the required activities of sororities and fraternities, or other activities in which you may choose, but are not required to participate.

Unexcused absences will lower your grade by 10 points for each absence. You are required to fill out the absence form below to receive an excused absence.

Tardy/Absence policy: More than 3 minutes late is tardy. 3 tardies=1 absence. More than 20 minutes late is an absence.
